The judges will be looking for evidence of: - Legal expertise and innovation - Project management skills - Teamwork - Client satisfaction and value for money If submitting your entry as an attachment, please note the word count, which should not be over 800 words. 1) Deal outline - describe the case and why it was important. 2) Team's role - what was your team's role on the deal or case, include details of team members and lead lawyer and explain why your team excelled against the following criteria: legal expertise and innovation, project management skills and team working. 3) Outcomes - provide evidence of client satisfaction and the 'value' your team brought to the table. What difference did the team make?
